## 2025 ATHS Educational Scholarships Close April 15 Four \$3,000 Scholarships Available

**KANSAS CITY, Mo. (February 27, 2025)** — The American Truck Historical Society (ATHS) is now accepting applications for the George Schroyer Memorial Scholarships, the Cummins Scholarship, and the Louis Semple Clarke Educational Fund.

The George Schroyer Memorial Scholarship provides two annual \$3,000 scholarships, while the Cummins Scholarship offers one \$3,000 award. These scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors or undergraduates pursuing further education at an accredited two-year or four-year U.S. college or university, or a vocational/technical school with certification programs.

“Our scholarships are a benefit of membership,” said ATHS Executive Director John Gravley. “While ATHS offers youth memberships, any member in good standing for at least two years, along with their immediate family members, is eligible to apply. Additionally, past recipients who meet the criteria may reapply.”

### **The students eligible for assistance shall:**

1. Be graduating seniors or undergraduates.
2. Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA (with curriculum rigor considered) based on a four-point scale, and regularly attend classes.
3. Be an ATHS member or an immediate family member (child, stepchild, or grandchild) of a member in good standing for at least two years.

The Louis Semple Clarke Educational Fund, sponsored by Autocar, LLC and the ATHS Autocar Division Chapter, honors Autocar Company founder Louis Semple Clarke. This \$3,000 scholarship is available exclusively to Autocar Company employees and their immediate family members who meet the 3.0 GPA requirement.

Preference for all scholarships will be given to applicants pursuing careers in the trucking or transportation industry. Financial need, community service, and extracurricular activities will also be considered.
